- listeners may not make the hard distinctions between "news, sports, business news, etc etc" Radio people make those pigeon holes.
- what does an anchor sound like?
Why do so many anchors and newsmen sound like alike?
- The way you are at home is the way you really are. That is your personality. How may radio people are "at home" what we hear?
- trying to "become" a personality is like trying to be taller. Your personality already IS. You just fail a way

to put it across. What you are is what you get.

- Why do "non-anchors" leap off the radio at you when you hear one? Because they are so "unprofessional" or because they have yet to learn to talk like an "anchor"?

Thing to do: set up something with Andy Tudden, KMBZ. Make it a Columbia (Kevin Meyer).

Follow up on Bob's 3x5 Card news cast.
